By attending modules 2,3 and 4, participants similarly improve their industry knowledge and practical skills, without having to pass an exam or write a research paper on an arbitration topic.

The SAA also offers participants the opportunity to attend **Individual Modules**. This possibility is ideal for practitioners or advanced students with a specific interest, as well as for professionals in different areas of law who wish to serve as arbitrator in the future.
